Progress Reports will be available in the front office, starting at 4:00PM on 9/22/16.

- 1. Check in at the Front Office from 4:00-6:45PM
- 2. Pick up your child's progress report (divided by alphabetical order)
- 3. Then, if you desire to meet with your child's teacher(s) for a short conference, proceed to the library and MPR to discuss classroom performance and grades from 4:00-7:00PM. (Please note: Last conferences will begin at 6:45, in order to end by 7:00PM)
 - a. Library = 6th Grade Teachers by alpha order of last name
 - b. MPR = 7th, 8th, PE, & Elective Teachers by alpha order of last name
 - c. Library Computer Center = Library computers will be available for parents to immediately email teachers, if you need additional time/information or to request a more formal conference

If you cannot attend this evening event, all remaining Progress Reports will be sent home with the student on Monday, September 26.
